



Dear Parent/Guardian:

Welcome to the 2018-2019 School Year! A healthy breakfast is provided free to all students every school day. **Your child may qualify for free or reduced price lunch.** Lunch is \$3.00. The reduced price is \$0.40.

Who is eligible for free or reduced price lunch?

- ✓ Children in households receiving CalFresh, FDPIR or CalWORKs;
- ✓ Children who meet the definition of foster, homeless, runaway, or migrant;
- ✓ Children may qualify based on household size and income. Households must apply to qualify.

What if someone in my household is not a citizen? The district does not release information to immigration. You will not be deported, denied entry to the US or denied permanent status for receiving free or reduced price lunch.

My child does not qualify for free meals, how can I pay for their lunch? To ensure each student has enough time to go through the lunch line, payment will not be accepted during lunch.

- ✓ Pay on-line at: ezschoolpay.com beginning August 16;
- ✓ Pay in the cafeteria or school office before 10 am;
- ✓ Send payment with your child’s information to the office.

What if I forget to add money to my child’s account? Students may charge up to three meals. You are responsible to ensure the account is up to date or to pack a lunch. We can help you with the meal application.

What if I don’t qualify now? If you become unemployed, your child may qualify. Other income or household changes may cause your child to qualify. You may reapply at any time.

What if I am on WIC? Your child may qualify for free or reduced price meals. Please submit an application.

Will the information I give be checked? We may ask you to send written proof of household income.

What if I disagree with the school’s decision about my application? You should talk to school officials. You also may ask for a hearing by calling or writing to: Nutrition Services Director **14120 S. Hawthorne Blvd (310) 263-3990**
